PARA KARATE	
Athletes with visual impairment (individual)	Blindfolds are required for all Visually Impaired Athletes during the kata performance
Athletes with physical impairment (individual)	This class will compete using wheelchairs.

CONDITIONS

- This championship is open to WKF affiliated members only
- WKF-rules will be applied. Repechages and two third places for all categories
- Age categories are based on the competitor's age on the day of the championship
- If a category does not have enough participants, it may be merged with another category
- Each team may bring a maximum of two referees. Compensation will be arranged by agreement

KATA RULES

- Competitors under 14 years old are allowed to repeat kata
- 14-15 years old: two different kata must be performed before repetition is allowed
- 16 years and older: a different kata must be performed in each round
- U10, U12, U1 categories will have two competitors on the tatami simultaneously.

KUMITE RULES

- Competitors must have the following protective gear: blue and red competition belt, blue and red gloves, blue and red foot/shin guards, chest protector, groin protector, and mouthguard. Are mandatory for all competitors
- For U12 and younger, head protection is mandatory. This can be borrowed at the tournament.
- Coaches and competitors must be ready when called and follow all instructions from officials to ensure a smooth competition flow.

MATCH DURATION

- U10: 1 minute; U12 and U14: 1 minute 30 seconds; U16 and U18: 2 minutes; Seniors: 3 minutes

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Competitors must be in the venue at least 60 minutes before the start of their category
- Only competitors and authorized coaches are allowed in the competition area
- All medalists must wear a karate gi or club tracksuit during the award ceremony
- A professional photographer may take pictures during the event for promotional purposes
- Anyone with concerns should contact the event team prior to the event
- It is the responsibility of each individual, or parent of a competitor if under 18 years of age, to have their own insurance cover for the event. Please advise your competitors accordingly regarding insurance cover. It is the responsibility of the clubs and coaches to ensure that all competitors are aware of this and have been advised of adequate cover
- The event team cannot accept responsibility for any such injury, loss or accident arising from your participation in our event and ask that you are aware, agree and accept this by entering or giving permission to enter this event
- Each competitor (or their parent if under 18) is responsible for their own insurance cover
- The organizers, venue and event staff cannot accept responsibility for any injury, loss or accident resulting from participation in this event

- We do not provide accommodation or act as an intermediary
- We can recommend hotels in the area and provide contact details upon request
